With this, I pledge to comply with the instructions and management of Ehime University.

- Except for the country/region of my departure, I will not stay in any countries/regions where Japanese travel bans apply within 14 days prior to arrival.
- I will comply with the requests of the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare after entering Japan.
- I will not make any personal contacts or actions that could lead to the spread of the COVID-19 infection.
- If I have any COVID-19 symptoms, including fever, respiratory symptoms, malaise, etc., within 14 days of departing for Japan, I will cancel my travel plans.
- I have checked the infectious disease risk level of my country/region on the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs' Overseas Safety Web site and, if necessary, will undergo a test for COVID-19 within 72 hours prior to departing from my country/region of stay and obtain a certificate showing a negative result issued by a medical facility using the prescribed format. I will present the certificate to the quarantine and immigration officers when arriving in Japan.

I understand that if I cannot present the certificate or a copy of it I will be denied access to Japan based on the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.

- I will get insurance coverage as indicated by Ehime University upon entering Japan. Or I am already covered by Japan's National Health Insurance.
- I will install a LINE application on my phone upon entering Japan and use it for 14-days to inform the public health center of my home or place of stay after entering Japan.
- I will install the COVID-19 contact-confirming application designated by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare upon entering Japan, and utilize its functions for 14 days.

- I will retain location data using the smartphone map function, etc. for 14 days after entering Japan.
- At the time of entry, I will get tested for the novel coronavirus and will stay in the waiting area designated by the Chief of the Quarantine Station until the results are known and will not make any contact with other people.
- If I need a place to wait for the test results outside the airport, I will contact Ehime University and stay at a facility indicated by the University.
- I understand that for 14 days after entering Japan, transportation is limited to private cars, rental cars, or other hired transport (including transportation from the arrival airport to home).
- After getting the test result, I will wait for 14 days after entering Japan at the accommodation booked by the way the University instructs or my home recommended by the University and will not make any contact with unspecified persons.
- If I become symptomatic within 14 days after entering Japan, I will report to the University immediately. Also, I give my consent to the university to call the nearest “Outpatient Services for Returnees and Contact Persons” from my accommodation and give the information of the area where I was staying, and present it to the designated medical institution.
- If I become COVID-19 positive within 14 days of entering Japan, I agree to promptly present the location information after entering Japan stored on my smartphone to the health center and cooperate with them.
- I will follow the following infection prevention measures. ① Wear a mask ② Disinfect hands thoroughly ③ Avoid the “Three Cs” (Crowded places, Closed Spaces, Close Contact).
- If it is found that I have received landing permission by submitting false information when applying for my visa or the confirmation of submission of re-entry, or if I violate the above pledge, I understand that my status of residence may be revoked and I will be subject to deportation based on the provisions of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.
- I have contacted my supervisor or the academic affairs office at my faculty/graduate school and already obtained the approval of the dean of faculty/graduate school to make this pledge and application.
