Policy on Offering Common Education Courses in the Second Semester (3rd and 4th Quarter) of the
Academic Year 2022

Center for General Education

Based on the "Future Responses to COVID-19 " (notice dated June 23, 2022), the Center for General Education will basically offer common education courses in the second semester of the 2022 academic year (third and fourth quarter terms) in accordance with the following policy to ensure thorough infection control measures.

The policy is based on the judgment at the present time and may be subject to change depending on the infection situation.

Basic Policy

- ◆ Face-to-face classes will be conducted.

- ◆ However, the following courses will be offered via asynchronous distance learning.
 - Introduction to Social Skills
 - Introduction to Intellectual Property
 - Some of the subjects in the "Subject Inquiry" series
 - Subjects by field of study

Infection Control Measures on Campus

1. Please wear masks during class (non-woven masks are recommended) and wash your hands before and after class.

2. Please take your temperature and check your health every morning.

3. Do not come to school if you have a cough, fever, or any other symptoms of illness (including adverse reactions due to vaccination with the COVID vaccine).

Absences due to the above reasons will be treated as "absence for justifiable reasons", so please submit the prescribed Absence from Class Form to the class instructor at a later date.

4. Please return home promptly after class to avoid unnecessary stays on campus.

5. Please keep a proper distance with the others before or after classes, during lunch, etc.

6. Please follow any other necessary instructions as determined by the department dean, class instructor, etc.

Precautions for Face-to-Face Classes

1. Please be sure to bring your student ID card with you as attendance will be checked in case of unforeseen circumstances (e.g., identification of persons in close contact).

2. Please prepare and wear a mask by yourself.

3. Hand sanitizer is available in front of the classrooms, so please be sure to disinfect your hands.

4. Please be sure to take your temperature every morning to monitor your health. If you have a cough, fever, or any other signs of illness, please do not come to school. Thermometers can be used at the faculty desks listed in the "Contact Information" below.

5. If a simultaneous remote class and a face-to-face class are scheduled on the same day, students may use the place on campus where they can take the remote class.

6. Face-to-face classes may be changed to remote classes depending on the infection situation. The instructor in charge of the class will contact you in advance in case of a change in how to hold the class.

7. If you have any questions or requests regarding the classes, please contact the faculty member in charge of the class or the teams listed in the "Contact Information" below.

Types of "Distance Learning

(1) Synchronous (real-time) type

This is a type of remote class in which the teacher conducts the class in real time to remote learners by using internet conferencing systems such as Teams, Webex, Zoom and so on. It is possible to exchange video and audio in both directions, and files can also be displayed. Since the class is conducted in real time, it is necessary to participate in the system on the days and times designated by the teacher.

(2) Unlisted synchronous (stored) type

This is a form of learning in which learners can access and study the materials that teachers have stored on the web server anytime they want. Since this is not a real-time system, questions and answers are exchanged via e-mail.
