学生の海外渡航について（通知）

令和3年10月20日に通知しておりましたこのことについて、令和4年5月18日開催の部局長協議会において一部改正されましたので改めて通知いたします。

本学の方針については、以下のとおりですが、海外渡航については、事前に必ず指導教員等に相談を行い、所属学部長／研究科長の許可を得るようお願いします。

また、私事渡航であっても、必ず事前に海外渡航届（修学支援システム）を所属学部長／研究科長に提出するようにしてください。

なお、各国の感染状況は日々変化しています。本通知は渡航を勧めるものではありませんので念のため申し添えます。

※海外渡航中に危険レベルが上がり、帰国勧告等が発出された場合は、安全・確実に帰国できるように次第、速やかに帰国すること。

※厚生労働省の指定する入国時の措置については頻繁に変更があるため、厚生労働省 HP 「水際対策に係る新たな措置について」をこまめに確認し、それに沿った対応をすること。相手国への入国時の対応のみならず、帰国時の対応に関しても十分に情報を収集して計画を検討し、必要経費を含めた対策が必要です。

Overseas Travel for Students (Notice)

We would like to reiterate our notification of this matter, which was issued on October 20, 2021 because it was partially revised at the meeting of the Directors and Deans that was held on May 18.

The University's policy is as follows, but please be sure to consult with your supervisor and obtain permission from your dean of faculty or grad.school in advance.

Even if the trip is private, you must submit the Temporary Leave Notification for Travel Abroad to your dean of faculty or grad.school in advance (through the Study Support System).

Due to the emergence of mutated strains, the infection situation in each country is changing every day. Please note that this notice does not recommend your overseas travel.

- If the University's BCP level (of "execution of duties") is 3, permission must be obtained from the Director of the Crisis Response Headquarters (President); if the BCP is level 2 (of "execution of duties") or lower, permission must be obtained from the Dean of the faculty or grad.school.

- For dangerous information and infectious disease warning level of the destination related to overseas travel, if the levels are different, the higher level shall be applied.
- If the University's BCP level (of "execution of duties") is 3, you must submit a notification to the Director of the Crisis Response Headquarters (President); if the BCP is level (of "execution of duties") 2 or lower, you must submit a notification to the Dean of the faculty or grad.school.

※As there are frequent changes to the entry measures specified by MHLW, it is advisable to check the MHLW website " New Measures for Waterfront Countermeasures " frequently and follow them accordingly.
