Request for Submission of Health Certificate and Health Check Form

Ehime University requires confirmation of the health condition for all new students in preparation for their school life, in order to protect them against infections such as tuberculosis.

All new international students are required to do the following:

Procedure

Before enrollment: Get a medical checkup including a chest X-ray in your home country or Japan within two months before.

*Please submit the form to the International Relations Office at Ehime University at least three weeks prior to enrollment.

*If you fail to submit your Health Certificate, you will not be permitted to reside in a university dormitory, such as Miyuki Dorm and International House.

Before moving to Ehime: Please report to the International Relations Office if you had been treated by a doctor or been hospitalized.

If you feel sick before leaving your home country, please make sure to see a doctor or use the health counseling service at the quarantine station at the airport where you enter Japan.

When you first come to Ehime University: Submit your Health Check Form to the International Relations Office (located on the second floor in the Aidai-Muse building)

If your family also live in Japan, please submit the above forms for all those members.

After enrollment, you will be required to have a health checkup provided by the university.
