He was born in South Africa. He completed a PhD degree, specializing in Artificial Intelligence and Engineering, from the University of Cambridge (UK) in 2000. From 2018 to February 2023, Prof. Marwala served as Vice-Chancellor and Principal of the University of Johannesburg in South Africa. His research has been multidisciplinary, involving the theory and applications of artificial intelligence to engineering, social science, economics, politics, finance, and medicine.
