He was born in South Africa. He completed a PhD degree, specializing in Artificial Intelligence and Engineering, from the University of Cambridge (UK) in 2000. From 2018 to February 2023, Prof. Marwala served as Vice-Chancellor and Principal of the University of Johannesburg in South Africa. His research has been multi-disciplinary, involving the theory and applications of artificial intelligence to engineering, social science, economics, politics, finance, and medicine.
